




Abb. 2. Janus-Epidiaskop, Mod. II mit 150 cm Kondensator.

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Sensible Control Is Suggested for Children Who Are Radio Addicts

BY MYRTLE MEYER ELDRED.

A mother does not need to be told that children become radio addicts and spend a good share of their leisure time with ears pasted to the instrument. This behavior is more acute from 8 to 12 than after this age. The older child has such a multitude of interests, both social and school, that the radio has to take its place as only one of them.

Mrs. F. Y. T. thinks her 7-year-old boy spends too much time indoors listening to the radio. She writes, "I deplore his demands to buy all kinds of advertised foods so he can send box tops and get some silly trophy. His sleep is disturbed by the excitement of the blood-and-thunder programs and he tends to act like a young criminal, pointing his gun at everyone and asking in a hoarse voice, 'Come clean!'"

"Shall I deny him the right to listen to the radio and what shall I do about the advertising?"

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

NEW YORK — The staccato tweet of the paging beeper, which is the latest in high-technology gear for the enterprising drug dealer, is being squelched in schools across the country.

School systems are forbidding students to carry the pagers, about the size of a pack of cigarettes, on the ground that they are often used to arrange illegal drug sales.

Pagers are widely used by doctors, lawyers and other professionals. But educators say this use of beepers by drug dealers is particularly hampering their efforts to prevent drug abuse among teenagers.




WASHINGTON, Feb. 24 — Does technological progress, by increasing the efficiency of our industrial processes, take jobs away faster than it creates 'hem? On this question Dr. Karl T. Compton, president of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, clashed a few days ago with President Roosevelt.


